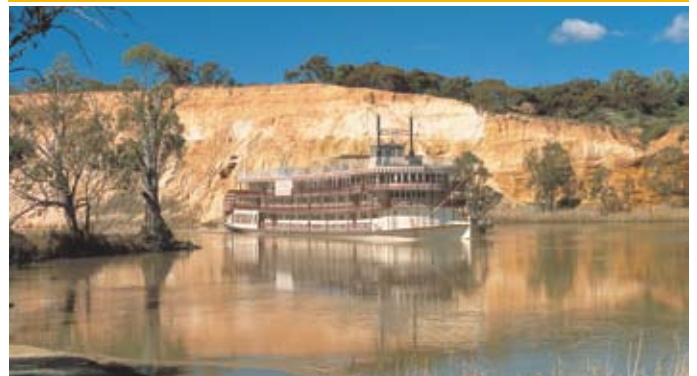

Snorkel over reefs on the edge of the continental shelf. Ribbon No.5 is a true barrier reef with an amazing array of corals and a kaleidoscope of tropical fish.
